Cheques and e-transfers must be received within 1 week of entering online or your entry may be voided.

Bitches in season (BIS) may participate but we must be notified ahead of time. Handlers must limit movement of the BIS and only use the designated relief area. A BIS must wear panties at all times on the property, including during the run except while in the designated relief area. The BIS will run at the end of each class and the handler must provide a mat for the start line. Competitors who chose not to compete because there is a BIS will be offered a credit for the next trial.

MOVE UPS

Move-ups from prior trials must be reported no later than one week prior to the trial. Please contact the Trial Secretary. We will attempt to also accommodate same day move-ups when possible.

Measuring

To compete, dogs over 2 years old need two official measurements, their final height circled on their permanent Dog ID card, and this card signed by the judge of record at the trial. Dogs under 2 years need only one measurement on their temporary card until they turn 2, at which point they require official measurements. You do not need to have your under-2-year old dog measured at every trial.

Obstacle Familiarization: Available for all starters dogs on contact equipment only. Toys are allowed in the ring during familiarization but not food.

Trial Rules

This event is held under the AAC Rules and Regulations (as of January 1, 2023) and is open to all dogs, purebred or mixed breed, that are at least 18 months old, except lame, blind or aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect their physical or mental performance.

By submitting an entry, exhibitors agree that they know and understand AAC Rules and Regulations, including but not limited to the following:

- Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the AAC Rules and Regulations and shall conform to AAC specifications.
- At the handler's discretion, a dog is allowed to wear a close-fitting collar, with no attachments, in the ring.
- At the discretion of the HOST CLUB, toys (but no squeaky toys or toys holding food) MAY be allowed on course for FEO runs. If toys are allowed, please consider the dogs running before and after you, because your toy may distract a dog on course and overexcite the dog following you.
- Senior handlers (65 years and over) and handlers with disabilities may request a modified course time and a modified points requirement. Host clubs will not request proof of disability or age. A handler must indicate before the trial if entering as a senior/disabled handler to receive modified times/reduced number of points. Contact the trial secretary to make this request.
- All dogs must be kept in a vehicle, pen, crate, or on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be in control when entering and leaving the ring. Any dog engaging in aggressive, out-of-control behaviour will be disqualified and/or be required to leave the Fairgrounds. In such cases, fees will not be refunded.
- No food, toys, or any other aids or devices are permitted on course; however, silent, food-free toys are allowed during obstacle familiarization.
- Spring Hill farm is an on-leash area. Owners of this privately run facility have the authority to ask exhibitors to keep their dogs on leash while not in the ring, or to leave the facility. No refunds will be offered to people who are asked to leave.
- Exhibitors are responsible for the behaviour of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behaviour may be asked to leave the venue. In such cases, fees will not be refunded.

Entries, Cancellations and Refunds Entries:

The number of entrants is limited. When the allotted number of handlers/runs has been reached on the Agility Rocks program, the program closes. To have your name put on a wait list, email the trial secretary at niroadsters@yahoo.ca. Roadsters reserves the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not in good standing with AAC or Roadsters will not be allowed entry. Please use online payment if possible. However, to use any gift certificates as part of your entry fee, please mail these to the trial secretary plus your cheque for the balance. Make cheques out to "Roadsters Agility Club" and date them on or before the trial closing date. You may also send an e-transfer niroadsters@yahoo.ca. There will be a \$30 charge on NSF cheques. Cancellations and Refunds: With each refund request, a \$5.00 administration fee will be charged. Refunds for cancellations after the closing date will only be given in these cases:

- Handler illness,
- Pregnant bitches, or
- Injury to a dog that physically prevents it from competing. NB: Roadsters may request a vet's note to confirm a dog's injury. Refunds requested for any other reason than the above will be handled on a case-by-case basis and will be at the discretion of Roadsters Agility Club

Volunteers We ask that all entrants help with the trial. Draws for volunteer prizes will be drawn on Saturday and Sunday. Thank you in advance. Without volunteers we would not be able to hold trials.
